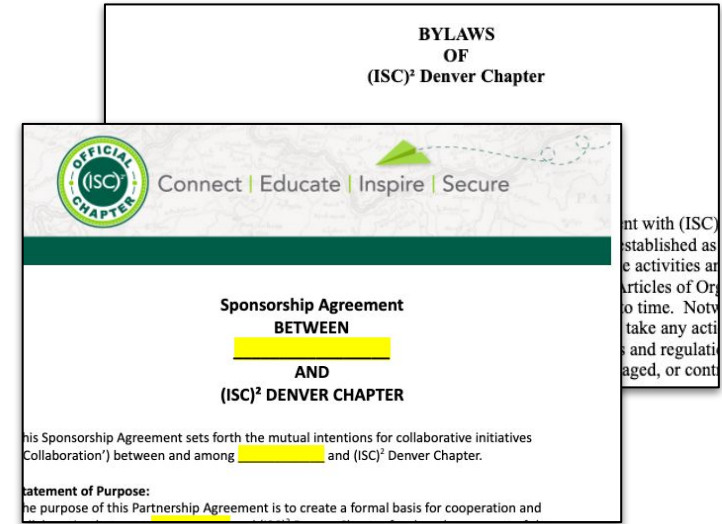
Our chapter provides current and aspiring security professionals an open forum to facilitate the exchange of knowledge and ideas, develop leadership and professional skills, and advance information systems security.
